### ADMISSION FOR 2014/2015 ACADEMIC YEAR ADVOCATES TRAINING PROGRAMME

IT IS NOTIFIED for general information that the 2014/2015 academic year at the Kenya School of Law shall commence on **13<sup>th</sup> January 2014**. Candidates seeking admission to the School are required to forward their applications together with the following mandatory documents:

- a) A copy of the applicant's LL.B Degree Certificate;
- b) Copies of academic Transcripts\*;
- c) Copies of KCSE Certificate, or KCE/GCE/KACE Certificate;
- d) A copy of National Identity Card, or a valid Passport (for foreign students);
- e) Two passport size colour photographs;

Applications not accompanied by the mandatory documents, or sent after the closing date shall not be acknowledged.

\*To be considered for admission, the LL.B Degree **MUST** be from a recognized University or College under the Council of Legal Education Act, 2012 and comprise **all** the following **16** core subjects as per Council of Legal Education Act, 2012. Note further that candidates with incomplete transcripts shall not be considered.
